




Among the new attractions are:


- The new center kiosk features the Commonwealth statue built with legos, and floor projection games that visitors can play to learn fun facts about Pennsylvania.

All these improvements are designed to make the center even more welcoming to visitors of all ages and bring alive the Capitol's rich history and beauty.














Access from Third Street (Main Capitol Entrance)

Come through the revolving doors of the Main Entrance, go to the rear of the marble staircase and proceed straight down the hallway until you come to the escalator. Go down the escalator and past the cafeteria, then turn left at the Information Desk to the Welcome Center.

Access from Commonwealth Avenue (East Wing Entrance - Handicap Accessible)

Come through the doors of the East Wing Entrance past the Information Desk and turn right to the Welcome Center.
